Students who accumulate more than two (2) absences during a semester will be in violation of the 90% attendance rule and may be denied credit for that semester. Days missed due to late registration will be counted as absences.</p> <p>A student will be counted as “tardy” after 7:30 a.m. A student is counted as “absent” after 7:50 a.m.</p> <p>A parent or guardian must call the summer school office between 7:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. to report a student’s absence.</p> <p>Do not request permission to take trips or attend camps.</p> <p>Two avoid unexcused absences; these procedures must be strictly followed. Violation of this attendance policy will result in loss of class credit. No refunds will be issued!</p>		
Dress Code:	The Garland ISD Dress Code will be strictly enforced! Failure to adhere to the GISD Dress Code will result in dismissal from the Summer School Program.
