







## Legend for Indicators Used in Course Descriptions

Indicator	Meaning
<b>(IB) or (InH)</b>	Either of these indicates that the course will receive International Honors grade points
<b>(AP), (PreAP), or (H)</b>	Either of these indicates that the course will receive Honors grade points.
<b>(DC)</b>	Indicates the course will receive Dual credit grade points,
<b>(R)</b>	Indicates the course will receive Regular grade points.
<b>(B)</b>	Indicates the course will receive Basic grade points.
<b>(NGP)</b>	Indicates that the course does not receive grade points.
	Indicates a STAAR EOC Bridge course.
	Indicates an Advanced Placement(AP) or PreAP course.
<b>CCM</b>	Indicates a College & Career Magnet course at Lakeview Centennial High School.
	Indicates a Dual Credit course which allow students to earn credit for a high school course and a college course at the same time.
<u><b>ELL</b></u>	Indicates a course for English Language Learners.
	Indicates an International Baccalaureate or International Honors course at Garland High School.
<b>MST</b>	Indicates a Math, Science & Technology Magnet course at North Garland High School.
	Indicates a Special Education course.
	Indicates an Articulated Tech Prep course. These high school career and technology courses allow students to earn college credit after graduating from high school and enrolling in a college offering programs in this field.
