#GISDchat Twitter Chat Guidelines

Always use #GISDchat when you post in the chat.

Introduce yourself using your professional Twitter account. Share your name, campus/department, grade/content level and other pertinent info that helps connect you with others in the chat.

Don't just answer questions; reply to others! Remember, this is a conversation, not a Q and A session.

If you come in late, be sure to jump into the conversation that is currently taking place. You can go back and read the previous questions and answers later.

Acknowledge other's observations and comments. This is a great way to build your PLN and gain new followers!

Number your answers to match the questions to which you are replying (for example, Q1 is answered with A1).

Don't be afraid to be a lurker! This is a great way to test the waters and get familiar with the Twitter chat forum.

Remember that what you post in a chat is still visible to the rest of your followers! Use the messenger to send private messages to another participant!
