Mission Statement

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Goal 1: Garland ISD will ensure ALL students graduate prepared for college, careers, and life by increasing student performance measures, postsecondary readiness, and graduation rates and decreasing student management incidences.

Performance Objective 1: Percent of students in grade 3 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Reading, will increase from 77.4% in 2019 to 90% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 78.9%)

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 2: Percent of students in grade 4 demonstrating early literacy as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Writing, will increase from 70.6% in 2019 to 70% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 72.1%)

Performance Objective 3: Percent of ELL students demonstrating English language acquisition, as measured by earning yearly progress indicator on the Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS), will increase from 51.1% in 2019 to 76% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 52.6%)

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 4: Percent of students in grade 5 demonstrating scientific understanding as measured by Meets Grade Level performance on STAAR Science, will increase from 87.8% in 2019 to 80% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 88%)

Performance Objective 5: Percent of students demonstrating mathematical proficiency, as measured by Meets Grade Level performance by the end of grade 5 on STAAR Math will increase from 90.8 % in 2019 to 90% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 91%) grade 4, 2019 increase from 81.2% to 84.8% 2020, and grade 3, 2019 increase from 89.3% to 92.9% 2020.

Performance Objective 6: Percent of student management incidents resulting in exclusionary consequences [i.e., In School Suspension (ISS), Out of School Suspension (OSS), and Reassignment Rooms] will decrease from 14.5% in 2019 to 35% by 2025. (SY1920 interim goal = 13.0%)

Performance Objective 7: During the 2019-2020 school year, 100% of Kimberlin families will be invited to parent education opportunities. 80% of parents will rate the event as successful as measured by parent surveys.
