- **International Baccalaureate (IB) World School**

- **Classical**
Continuation of the Latin, dance, gymnastics and piano instruction started in elementary and middle school.

- **Collegiate Academy**
Students earn a high school diploma and an Associate of Science degree (63 hours) from the Dallas County Community College District concurrently.

- **Law and Criminal Justice**
Targeted to students considering careers associated with a court, law enforcement, special services, forensics or corrections.

- **Television and Broadcasting**
Students work in a fully equipped production studio with a broadcast-quality control room and use field cameras, lighting and audio gear.

- **Global Business, Language & Leadership Magnet Program**
Provides students with an understanding of business, marketing and finance within a global context while also offering project-based learning activities that connect instruction to real-world applications.
 - Encourages students to be bilingual or multilingual with Mandarin Chinese courses.
 - Leadership development through community service, portfolios, global business student organizations and business competitions.
 - National or international study abroad summer learning experiences.

- **AP Capstone Diploma**
Equips students with the independent research, collaborative teamwork and communication skills that are increasingly valued by colleges.

- **Accelerated Math & Science**
Provides the opportunity to advance faster, taking more math and science classes throughout high school. Tracks include:
 - Math/Science Track
 - Fast Math/Science Track
 - Super Fast Math/Science Track

- **Project Lead the Way**
Engages students in hands-on activities, projects and problems, empowering them to solve real-world challenges.

- **Air Force JROTC**
Training in aerospace science, leadership, citizenship and health/fitness.
 - Includes team-building experiences, intramural competition and field trips.
 - Two years can earn college credit or a military rank if enlisting.

- **Virtual Business**
Teaches students the administrative, creative and technical skills needed to start an online company.

- **Geographic Information Systems (GIS)**
 - Used to create spatial pictures of information in the form of maps and other graphic media.
 - Many businesses use GIS to increase productivity and sales by efficiently constructing and supplying new locations on digital maps before important decisions are made. Crime analysts and local governments use GIS to examine crime statistics and relocate law enforcement services effectively.

- **Career Preparation**
Students work in unpaid positions to gain on-the-job experience.

SGHS

- **Automotive Technology and Collision Repair**
Students gain knowledge and skills in the repair, maintenance and diagnosis of vehicle systems.

- **Cosmetology**
Simulates a true salon environment and allows students to perform services for school and community members.

- **Electronics**
Trains students for career opportunities in both electrical and information technology-related fields.

GRCTC

- Students remain enrolled in their home campuses and travel to the GRCTC to attend courses for two class periods on either A day or B day.
- More than 90 advanced-level Career and Technical Education courses available, including culinary arts, veterinary medicine, fashion design, logistics and certified nursing assisting.

- New program offerings include firefighting/EMT, dentistry, cybersecurity and outdoor power sports.
